If you need a new one, put your name on the green sheet on the glass-topped cabinet in the main entrance. It will be on the name tag rack the following Sunday.



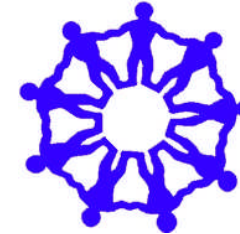

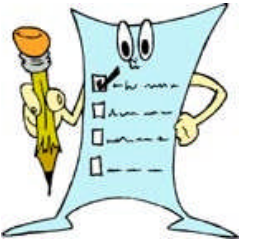

**Event Planning Form**

The Event Planning Form  
(formerly known as the "Pink Slip") is  
a tool that serves both the group plan-  
ning the event and the staff in sup-  
porting your event. Filling out the form  
helps your group consider all aspects  
of an event, gives all of the details needed to be able to  
put the event on the church calendar, and allows the  
staff to understand your activity so that set up and clean  
up can be planned into their work schedules. On the  
back is a simple diagram of Park Hall, the most used  
room, to assist in planning the set up. This diagram  
makes an easy quick reference for the sexton as he gets  
the room ready for the event.



The Event Planning Form is available on the main  
bulletin board in the narthex corridor and also on the St.  
Martin's website under the "Looking for...?" pane in the  
left column under Schedules – Forms – Policies.

It is a good idea to keep a copy for your records and  
to serve as a reminder to publicize your event. At the  
bottom of the form are some helps for writing an article  
to go into the Announcements and iMessages. If you are  
planning far enough ahead, it is always beneficial to get  
your write up in the Messages newsletter as this publica-  
tion is mailed to members and visitors as well as to sur-  
rounding parishes who might find your event of interest  
to their parishioners.
