## Finances

Last Sunday's Total Income: \$5,985. — Budgeted Income: \$6,117  
Total Income for Year: \$37,048 — Budgeted for Year: \$24,468  
Furnace & Air Conditioner Replacement Fund: \$23,048.

*From December 2010 Financial Report to the Vestry, approved at January 24, 2011 Vestry Meeting:*  
Year to date expenses have exceeded income by \$17,152.

[YTD actual income \$474,090 - YTD actual expenses \$491,242 = an actual deficit of \$102,079]

The year to date Budget projected that expenses would exceed income by \$102,079.  
[Budget Income \$398,135 - Budgeted Expenses \$500,214 = a deficit of \$102,079]

Income for the year has exceeded projections by \$75,954 and expenses were less than projected by \$8,972.

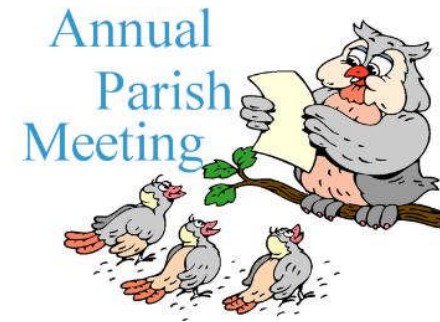
