### ► **Urban Mission Experience in St. Louis** **June 19 - 22**

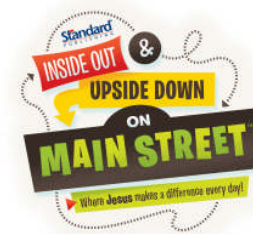

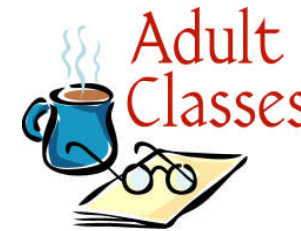
