Twenty-Five (25) percent to

Twenty (20) percent to
ST. MARTIN'S EPISCOPAL CHURCH

COMMUNITY CHRISTIAN CHURCH
of Manchester, Missouri;

and

Fifteen (15) percent to
THE SALVATION ARMY (MIDLAND DIVISION).

I direct each of the above institutions to maintain the funds bequeathed to them by this Will and the funds to be distributed to them from the G. H. Packwood, Jr., Indenture of Trust, dated January 20, 1966 and amended on September 18, 1968 and amended on September 8th, 1971, in a separate fund. The governing body of each such institution shall have the power to expend the income from such fund for the charitable purposes of such institution. In addition the governing body of each institution in its discretion shall have the power to expend the principal of the fund, but it is my desire that the principal be used only for the improvement of the plant, equipment and facilities of such institution."
