

Senior Warden Report

June 15, 2021

Here's a recap of my activities since the last Vestry meeting:

- The Regathering Committee met twice in May, and we discussed ongoing plans for re-opening. Since then, the diocese released updated guidelines, which we have reviewed. Most of them are workable, but we first need to chart out our maximum attendance given the new guidelines, and then submit an updated plan.
- In addition, I will share during Vestry the results of the recent Regathering Committee survey. Response rates were high, and the results indicate a strong willingness and comfort to return to in-person church, and a very high vaccination rate among respondents.
- Continued the dialogue on our insurance policy and coverage limits, following our last Vestry meeting. Terence got our final question answered about cybersecurity coverage, and we are ready to move forward with final Vestry approval. As a reminder, these changes will be credited to us retroactively to Feb. 2.
- Had an impromptu meeting with Lincoln and Page to discuss placement of the Columbarium expansion, and we believe we may have a workable solution. Will discuss further during Vestry.
